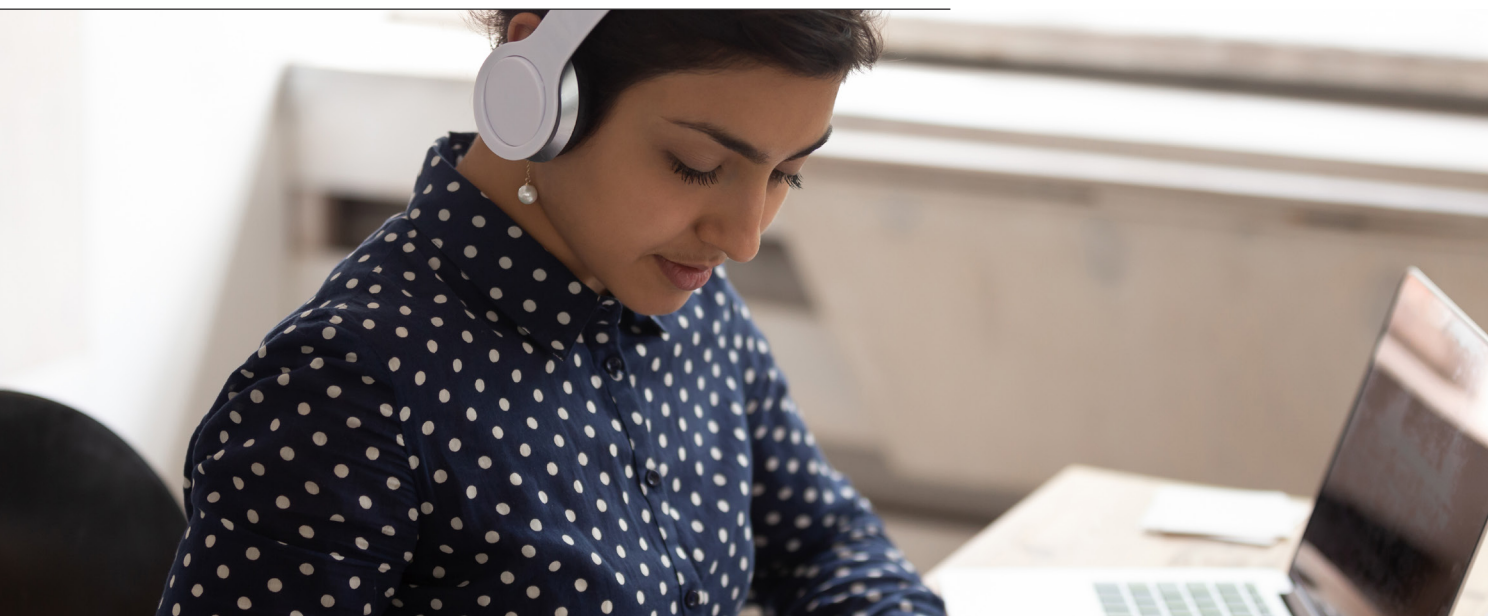

English Level Requirement: The program accepts students with Intermediate and Advanced levels of English. Students who do not have official English test score are required to take the SLC placement test to determine their English level.

REQUIREMENTS TO PROGRESS TO THE NEXT LEVEL OF STUDY:

FOR STUDENTS AT ADVANCED LEVEL (IEOP 70)

If you achieve 70% on the final grade, you are eligible to enter SLC Certificate and Diploma programs.

If you achieve 85%, you are eligible to enter Degree and Graduate Certificate programs.

FOR STUDENTS AT INTERMEDIATE LEVEL (IEOP 60)

If you achieve 60% on the final grade, you are eligible to go to the next level.

NOTE: *The credential earned from this program is only one piece required for admission to academic programs. Students are still required to meet other admissions requirements to enter the academic program. Different programs may have different requirements.
